



Accessing UpToDate®

1. To Access UpToDate, go to the Library's home page. From there, select UpToDate from the Databases & Articles section by choosing it in the dropdown box.

2. Log in through our Remote Access system using your euid (2 or 3 letters plus 4 number) and your regular network password. In order for your UpToDate account to be easily accessible either remotely or on-campus, everyone has to log in whether they are on- or off-campus.

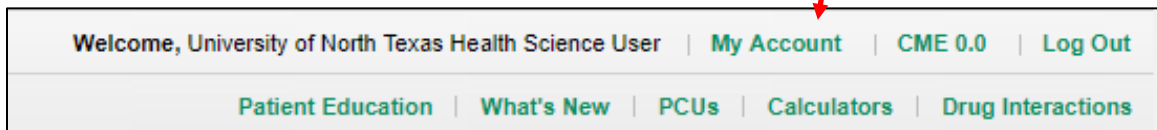
